

Packing List for Klondike and other Cold Winter Camping

Personal Scout Packing List (Class A Uniform will be worn during Travel)

Base Layer -

- Long underwear (polypropylene, silk)
- 2 - Socks (wool or synthetic)

Mid Layer -

- Long-sleeved shirt (wicking material, no cotton)
- Long Scout pants (no jeans, no shorts)
- Sweater or Sweatshirt (fleece or wool, no cotton)

Outer Layer -

- Winter Boots
- Warm Parka or Coat w/ Hood
- Beanie (Fleece or Wool)
- Water Resistant Mittens or Gloves
- Snow Pants or Shells

Additional Clothing -

- Warm/Dry Sweats (to Sleep in)

Additional Gear -

- Tent (If you don't have one they can sleep with other scouts)
- Flashlight
- Mess Kit
- Toiletries
- Sleeping Bag (recommend 2 for winter camping)
- Sleeping Bag Liner (Optional, but recommended)
- Foam Sleeping Pad
- Large Heavy Duty Trash Bag (for wet Clothes)
- Backpack
- Small/Lightweight Daypack (Optional)

Remember to dress in layers. You can always remove layers if too warm.
